At the November 8, 2006, ABRT membership meeting, the membership unanimously approved the recommendation of our Needs Assessment Subcommittee to request \$50,000 in funding under the Water Supply Reserve Account, specifically, from our Basin account. I have enclosed a copy of the actual motion for development of a needs matrix to assist our Needs Assessment Subcommittee in completing our charge under House Bill 1177 to further develop the needs assessment for our basin. As you are aware, we have internally adopted this SWSI I report for our preliminary needs assessment. The Roundtable and its Water Needs Assessment Committee has determined that it is very important to include SWSI I along with other reports and studies to develop a comprehensive needs matrix. We feel this can be completed in a team effort utilizing IBCC administrative funding under HB 1400 and their contractor, CDM, and contracting with the USGS utilizing water supply reserve account dollars that are the purpose of this grant application. We have included as an attachment to our letter of transmittal the actual Needs Assessment Subcommittee's recommendation to the Board and a detailed matrix on how this can be accomplished. We have worked with USGS in estimating the amount of money required to accomplish these tasks and goals.

Arkansas Basin Roundtable Needs Assessment Subcommittee

Motion for development of a Needs Matrix

The Needs Assessment Subcommittee requests that the Arkansas Basin Roundtable approves the following actions and commits its resources in furtherance of assessing the consumptive and non-consumptive water supply needs of the Basin as follows:

1. Authorize the Executive Committee and the Needs Assessment Subcommittee to:

a. Contract with the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) to complete a preliminary Needs Assessment Matrix.

b. Engage USGS to develop a map-based method of displaying the information contained in the Matrix.

c. Request funding under Senate Bill 179 of Fifty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (**\$50,000.00**) for such purpose.

2. Authorize the Chairman to make a written request of the Interbasin Compact Committee (IBCC) administrative office to commit funding under House Bill 1400 to accomplish tasks generally including:

a. Coordination with and collection, collation and screening of reports and studies from the Water Resource Research Institute of the Colorado State University, the Colorado Water Conservation Board, the Colorado Geological Survey and individual water agencies related to the Arkansas Basin.

b. Interface with the Arkansas Basin Needs Assessment Subcommittee and the USGS to provide the information gathered in a. above.

c. Organization of a "Working Group" of interested parties to develop a Geographic Information System (GIS) relational database for "*development of a common technical platform*" (IBCC Charter, Section IV ROLES OF THE COMMITTEE, item 4.).

d. Facilitate the meetings of the Working Group, including notices and meeting notes.
