Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chairperson Michelle Pierce.

Roll Call

Following roll call, it was declared that a quorum was not present.

Report from the IBCC Representatives

IBCC Representative Marc Catlin reported on the last IBCC meeting held on August 27-28, 2008 in Palisade. Marc said that the meeting was well attended, and many Roundtable members from the Denver area were present. The IBCC is in the process of putting the final touches on the visioning package to send out to the Basin Roundtables in order to give the opportunity for feedback from the Roundtables.

Report from the Educational Committee

George Sibley presented a publication to the Roundtable members prepared by Colorado State Extension Service that summarizes the IBCC process as well as Colorado Compacts and the legislation processes. These publications are available for distribution through the CSU Extension.

George invited any members to participate with the IBCC Education Working Group in planning for outreach to make the Roundtable process more visible.

Dixie Luke inquired about the Forest Service presentation. This presentation is rescheduled for December and will be primarily about Aspen decline.

David Kanzer announced the upcoming River District Water Seminar at the Two Rivers Convention Center in Grand Junction on Friday, September 19, 2008. An agenda was provided to the Roundtable members. The theme for this seminar is the Intra-State River Compact and how it would work.

1. Presentation by Arkansas Basin

Attorney Peter Nichols made a presentation on alternatives to permanent dry up of agricultural lands by using water leasing programs. Mr. Nichols discussed how this was working in the Arkansas Basin.

2. Consumptive Needs Assessment Task Order

Hal Simpson discussed their progress to more accurately depict per capita use of water in the Gunnison Basin. He indicated that there was not much response to requests for input. They contacted water providers and made the changes to the table in the report. The findings were that the SWSI numbers were mostly larger than the actual numbers.

3. IBCC Visioning Process

Sue Morea, CDM, presented the draft IBCC Vision and Strategies document. The document was discussed, and changes were requested. Sue requested any other comments from the Roundtable members be sent to her for the mid-October IBCC meeting.

4. Other

Ken Spann indicated that the Agricultural Water Shortage Subcommittee will be preparing and submitting a project proposal to the Roundtable for funding. Ken provided two documents: an Agricultural Water Shortage Subcommittee Report, and a Work Plan developed by Hal Simpson of CDM. The proposal will be requesting Basin funding due to the rapid startup of the project. The Upper Gunnison Water District will be the formal applicant and administrator for handling of the funds. The objective of this project is to get and develop the data needed to fill in the gaps on water shortages in the Needs Assessment data for the entire Gunnison Basin.

The Agricultural Water Shortage Subcommittee will meet with both the Needs Assessment Committee, and the Project Screening Committee, in preparation for submitting the project proposal.
