Summary

This is an application for approval of a change of seven irrigation water rights to multiple types of use within the service areas of Donala Water and Sanitation District, Pikes Peak Regional Water Authority, and Colorado Springs Utilities. Applicant requests new points of diversion and storage to places including Pueblo Reservoir, Turquoise Reservoir, Twin Lakes Reservoir, Otero-Arkansas Pump Station Intake, Excelsior Ditch/Stonewall Springs Reservoir, Colorado Canal, Lake Meredith Reservoir, Lake Meredith Outlet Canal, Lake Henry, Holbrook Canal, Holbrook Reservoir No. 1, Dye Reservoir, and Clear Creek Reservoir.

Applicant requests exchanges for 8.3 cfs from the confluence of Willow Creek and the Lake Fork to Turquoise Reservoir, from the confluence of the Arkansas River and Lake Creek to Twin Lakes Reservoir, and from the confluence of the Arkansas River and Clear Creek to Clear Creek Reservoir.
