Doug Scott chaired the meeting.

Rick Brown gave an update on new appointees to the Colorado Water Conservation Board. He also reviewed the steps for obtaining SB-179 funding for water resources projects. This process requires attention by the applicant to the CWCB Criteria and Guidelines, and completion of the application form. There is a minimum 60-day submittal and review period before project funding can be considered by the CWCB.

There were reports on the South Platte Roundtable and the Arkansas Roundtable meetings. The Arkansas Roundtable is beginning to have discussions with stakeholder groups concerning agricultural efficiencies with respect to the Arkansas River Compact. A summary report was also provided concerning the discussions and conclusions at the September 2007 groundwater conference in Colorado Springs.

David Nickum and Jonathan _____ gave a presentation from the Non-consumptive Needs Sub-committee. They presented a chart on non-consumptive categories in the Metro and South Platte basins, together with other information. They reported that non-consumptive assessment work is underway in all basins.

Rick Brown (CWCB) gave a presentation on SWSI – Phase II.
