Consent Agenda Item 1.b May 2010 Board Meeting Case No. 1-09CW272; Busk-Ivanhoe, Inc.

## **Summary**

This is an application for a change of water rights for the Busk-Ivanhoe System, which is a transbasin diversion historically used to bring water from the Frying Pan drainage in Water Division 5, to Water Division 1 for irrigation use. Applicant is proposing to change the type of use of the water rights to include all municipal and domestic uses, including among other uses, "allowable instream uses". Applicant plans to change the place of use to its service area in Water Division 1 for municipal water supply and water reuse anywhere within the South Platte River Basin area capable of being served by Aurora and to its current and future service obligation within the Arkansas River basin. Applicant is also proposing to store the changed water rights at various locations in Water Divisions 1 and 2. This same application has been filed with the Courts in Water Division 2 (Case No. 2-09CW142) and Water Division 5 (Case No. 5-09CW186).

## **CWCB Appropriations**

The CWCB holds decrees for instream flow water rights on numerous streams in Water Divisions 1, 2 and 5 that could be injured by this application.

## **Potential for Injury**

The change of water rights proposed in this case may result in an expansion of use, which could injure the Board's instream flow water rights. The claim to use the water right for instream uses should be evaluated because CWCB has exclusive authority over instream flows for certain purposes.
