Summary

This is an application for a change of water rights for Upper Lone Pine Lake Reservoir in Larimer County. Applicant is seeking to use Lower Lone Pine Lake Reservoir as an alternate place of storage for three conditional storage rights decreed to Upper Lone Pine Lake Reservoir. Applicant is seeking to enlarge the existing Lower Lone Pine Lake Reservoir to accommodate the additional storage.

The CWCB holds decrees for the following instream flow water rights that could be injured by this application.

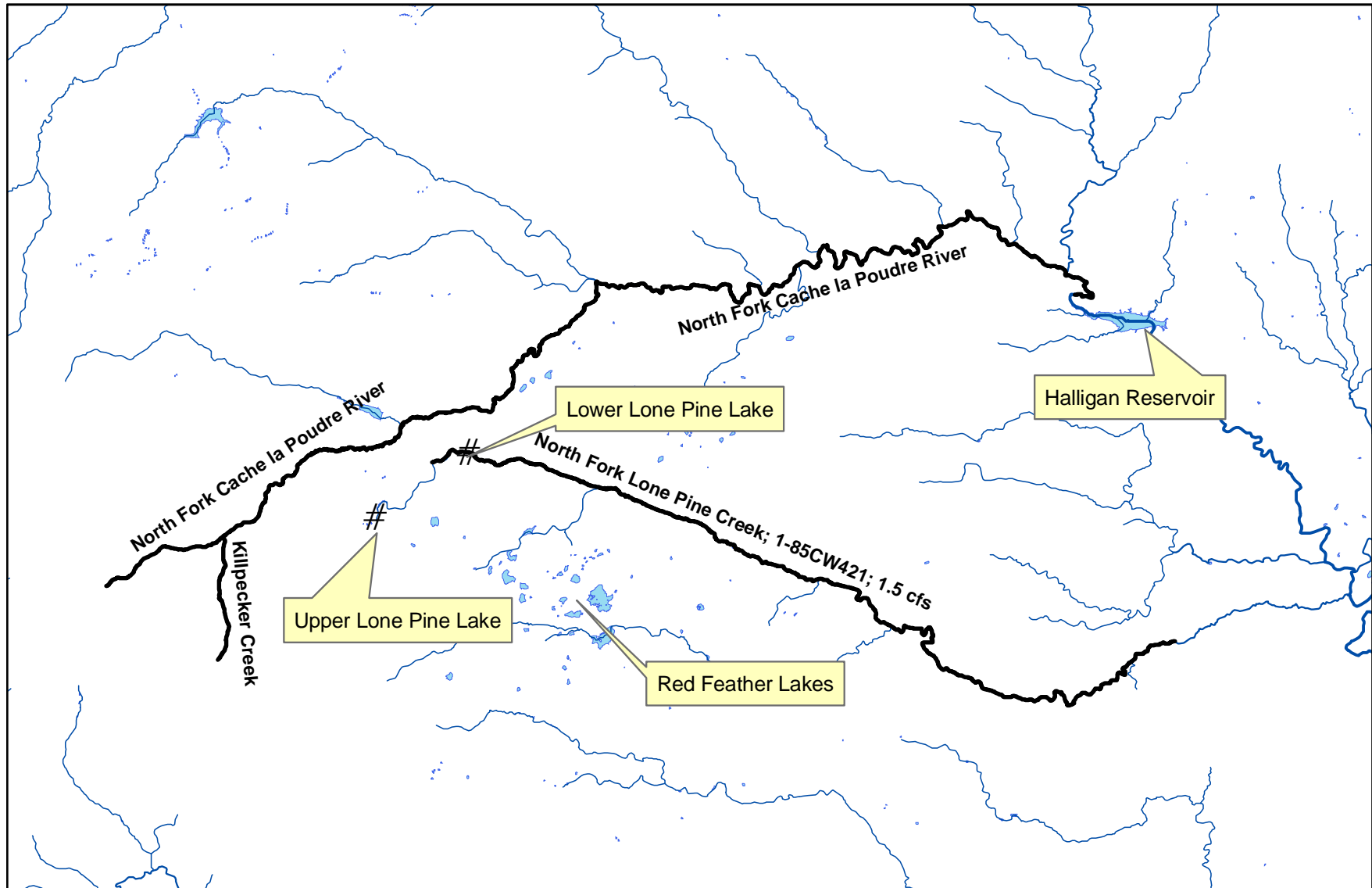
