

Summary

This is an application for an augmentation plan and exchange on the Eagle River near Edwards in Eagle County. Applicant is proposing to replace up to 500 acre feet of out-of-priority depletions resulting from municipal diversions at a number of surface and ground water diversion points along the Eagle River and Gore Creek. Augmentation water will be released from Ruedi Reservoir or Wolford Mountain Reservoir. Applicant is requesting a May 25, 2006 priority date for the Wolford Mountain exchange, and a February 10, 2009 priority date for the Ruedi Reservoir exchange. The maximum rate of exchange will be 10 cfs.

This same augmentation plan is pending in Case No. 5-06CW097, but in that earlier case, the applicant is claiming a 2006 priority date for the Ruedi exchange. CWCB is an objector in that case. Applicant has filed this new application in the event the court does not allow the earlier case to be amended.

The CWCB holds the following instream flow water rights that could be injured by this application:

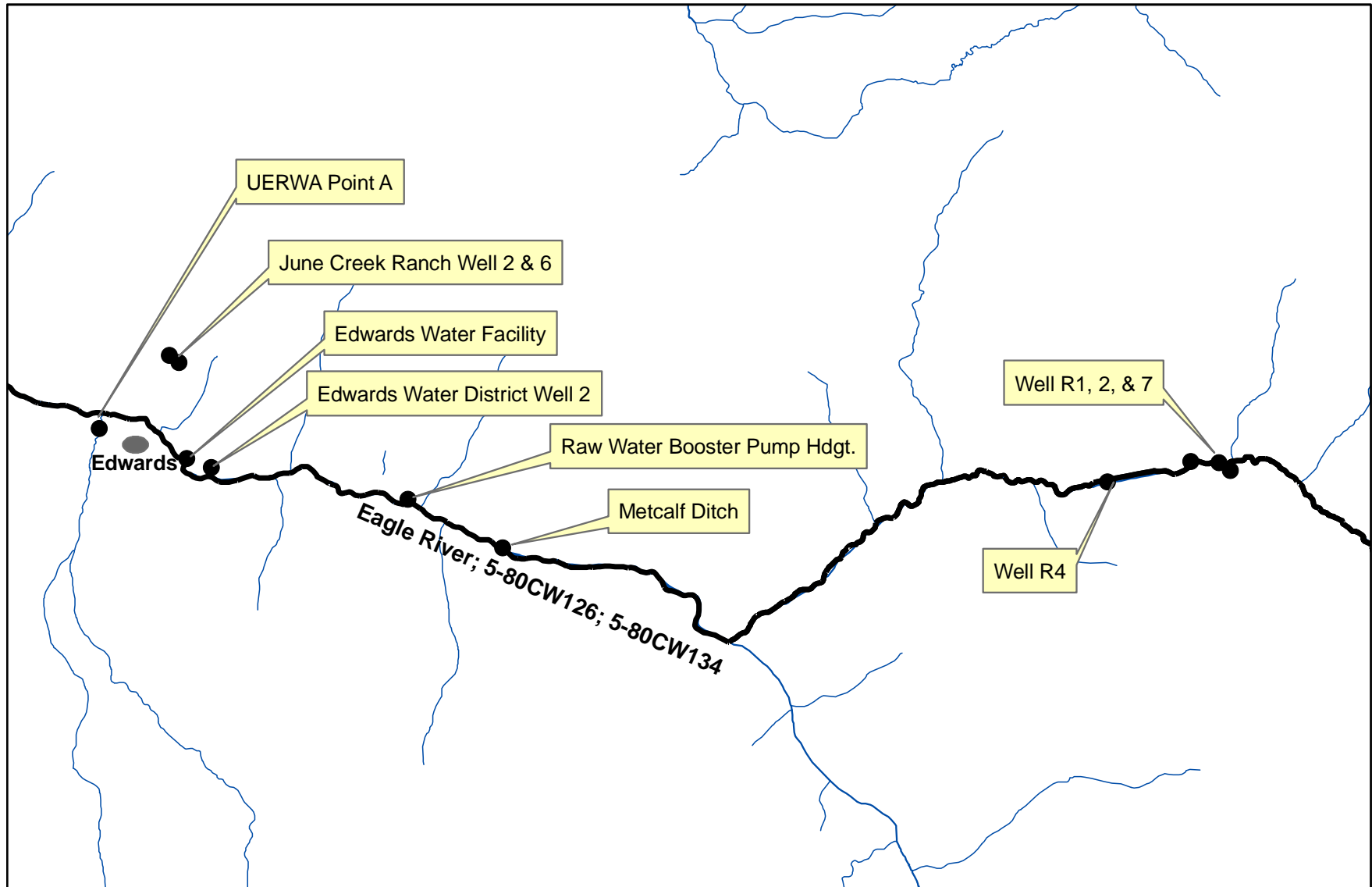
