Summary

This is an application for Change or Water Right, Approval of Plan for Augmentation and Exchange in Routt County. Applicant is proposing to change the use of 0.5 cfs of the Hoyle and Knight Ditch from irrigation to augmentation use. Applicant seeks to replace out-of-priority depletions by the Steamboat Springs Yampa River Municipal Well A with consumptive use credits associated with the Hoyle & Knight Ditch and with releases of water from Stagecoach Reservoir. The application includes an exchange of 0.5 cfs from the confluence of Fish Creek to the location of the well. Additionally, CWCB owns 4 cfs of the Hoyle & Knight Ditch water right which was changed to instream flow use in Case No. 76W959. The proposed plan for augmentation may not replace our-of-priority depletions in time, place and amount, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
