
# Stagestop Water Augmentation Reservoirs Project



- Total project cost is estimated to be \$212,000
- Association is requesting a \$190,800 loan
  - -4.25% interest rate
  - -20 year term







- Non-profit corporation (Est. 1976)
- Responsible for enforcing covenants & by-laws
- Annual meeting held in June
- Owners approved increase in assessments at that meeting (\$36/lot increase)
- Liens are placed against lots if dues are not paid



Well permits are owned by individual homeowners

- Association manages the augmentation plan
  - 20 AF out of Old House Creek
  - Augmentation plan approved in July 1976

• Financial Summary (Table 2)

• Loan \$192,700

• 4.25% interest for 20 year term (middle income reduced)

• \$15,945 annual loan payment (including 10% reserve account)

Assessment of \$36/lot will be collected to cover CWCB debt service

- Financial Ratios (Table 3)
- Association has no current debt
- Collateral will be a pledge of assessment revenues backed by a rate covenant and the water rights stored in Old House Creek
- Appraisal was completed on the water rights
