## **Reservoir Storage**

Reservoir storage is generally good with many reservoirs near or expected to be near 90 to100% of full storage. The key Municipal Reservoirs include; Dillon, Williams Fork, Homestake, and Jerry Creek Reservoir.

#### Streamflow

The streamflow across the basin ranges from 30% of average to 50% of average.
