

### **Summary**

This is an application for an absolute storage water right of 3.62 acre-feet and approval of a plan for augmentation to augment Elk Mountain Well No. 1, which is used for domestic and irrigation at 25 gpm. Upper and Lower Elk Mountain Reservoirs are listed as both structures to be augmented and structures to be used for augmentation. Other water rights to be used for augmentation include water from a Basalt Water Conservancy District Allotment Contract. The plan includes exchanges to utilize the Basalt Water Conservancy District water from Green Mountain Reservoir, Ruedi Reservoir and Robinson Ditch.
