The East Cherry Creek Valley Water and Sanitation District, with support from DiNatale Water Consultants and Kennedy-Jenks Consultants is preparing a Water Conservation Plan following the Guidance Document prepared by the Colorado Water Conservation Board. The draft plan was presented to the ECCV Board on August 26 and this draft plan submitted for CWCB review on September 3.

The following work has been accomplished, in accordance with the approved scope of work:

1. Profile of existing system and proposed facilities
2. Evaluation of current water use
3. Identification of existing conservation efforts
4. Identification and screening of proposed conservation measures
5. Demand forecasts with different conservation programs
6. Impacts of conservation programs
7. Implementation and Monitoring Plan

Initial comments on the draft plan were received from CWCB on September 10. A follow up conference call with CWCB staff was held on October 26. ECCV and its consultants are reviewing these comments and will discuss with CWCB staff and address the comments as needed. After conditional approval by CWCB, the public comment process will occur with final adoption of the plan following. As noted in the 50% completion report, ECCV anticipates that it may reallocate grant funds among its consultants, while maintaining the approved scope of work and total grant request. No changes to the scope of work or grant request are anticipated.
