WRCC, INC COBB LAKE INLET STRUCTURE PROJECT



Project Description

WRCC owns and operates six storage reservoirs in Larimer and Weld Counties including Cobb Lake. The inlet ditch to the Reservoir was badly eroded with vertical degradation which resulted in very steep side slopes that were a safety concern. The inlet structures were built in the early 1900s and have been patched together over the years to the point where sudden catastrophic failure could occur. If the inlet would have failed, the Reservoir could not be filled. The Company reconstructed the inlet structures and regraded/ reconfigured the inlet canal. Construction was completed in the spring of 2011.
