Greenway Grant Request

Jeff Shoemaker mentioned he will be coming to the roundtable in July for a WSRA request - \$250,000, \$25,000 from the Metro Roundtable, \$25,000 from the South Platte Roundtable, \$200,000 from the Statewide account. This project will be for Preliminary Design for the southern two sections of the South Platte Plan, and wants to take conceptual design to preliminary design.

CWCB News

Barbara Biggs – CWCB staff did present first draft on Colorado River instream flow proposal. Wild and Scenic Group gave testimony. Stream segment goes from Kremming to No Name.

Water Conservation Technical Advisory Group is convening. Be aware and participate.

Janet Bell – Is this group open to the public, there are many concerns about the group.

Tracey Bouvette – Water utilities are involved, right now these are all customer categories.

Tracey Bouvette - The data can be used to develop funding mechanisms to support needs to address what is working and what is not.

Janet Bell – This should be coming through the Metro Roundtable.

Jacob Bornstein – This will be used for Statewide Planning.

John Hendricks - Noise in the data, it is unlikely we will learn anything from this lost legislation.

Rod Kuharich/Barbara Biggs – We should ask for a Status Report.

Janet Bell – Very concerned about DRCOG- they have no expertise in water conservation.
