Based on public outreach and comments associated with the Colorado River Water Availability Study (CRWAS), the Colorado Water Conservation Board has embarked on a series (two rounds) of 2011 public and stakeholder outreach meetings and workshops. Earlier this year, CWCB and the CRWAS team provided a first round of Roundtable workshops to discuss public comments and corresponding refinements associated with the Draft CRWAS Phase I Report. Now, CWCB and the CRWAS team is holding a second round of CRWAS BRT workshops intended to engage stakeholders on refined CRWAS analyses and results. The goal of this second round of workshops is to provide stakeholders with a better understanding of how refined CRWAS results can be used for water resources planning purposes.
