### **Staff Recommendation**

Based on recommendations by the Board to proceed with scoping to respond to public comment on the Colorado River Water Availability Study (CRWAS) Draft Phase I Report and related outreach, a corresponding work plan has been developed. Staff recommends the Board direct staff to begin work associated with this plan that includes:

- Project Outreach
- Model Refinements
- Analysis Refinements
- Reporting Refinements

#### **Background**

Under SB 07-122 and HB 08-1346, the Colorado General Assembly directed CWCB to carry out the CRWAS. In 2007, CWCB staff worked closely with IBCC to develop a scope of work for Phase I. Several public outreach meetings were held to inform and obtain comments from basin roundtables. In March 2010, the draft Phase 1 CWRAS report was presented to the Board and made available to the general public over a 120-day review and comment period. At the end of this review period, over 500 comments were received from approximately 40 entities. A summary of these comments was provided to the Board in September 2010, from which came Board recommendation to scope an outreach and response strategy in coordination with basin roundtables. A work plan has since been developed with input from CWCB staff and basin roundtables to facilitate corresponding project outreach, model refinements, analysis refinements, and reporting refinements as described below.

#### Project Outreach:

- Develop response matrix for all formal comments; distribute to basin roundtables for review.
- Provide one-on-one communications with basin roundtable Chairs to discuss response matrix.
- Facilitate 1<sup>st</sup>-round basin roundtable workshops to discuss strategy for response to comments.
- Implement model, analysis, and reporting refinements listed below based on public comment.
- Facilitate 2<sup>nd</sup>-round basin roundtable workshops to discuss use of results and lessons-learned.
- Supplement workshops with multiple other forms of outreach at key project milestones including: CWCB Board Meetings, IBCC Meetings, Public Newsletters, and Public Data Posting.

<u>Model Refinements:</u> Implement refinements to climate projections and CDSS model parameters.

<u>Analysis Refinements:</u> Implement refinements to analysis resulting from above model refinements.

<u>Reporting Refinements:</u> Implement refinements to report and tech memos resulting from above refinements.

- Clarify expectations, limitations, uncertainty, use of results, and lessons learned.
- Replace Compact analysis with lessons-learned and overview of analysis complexities.
