Summary

This is an application for a new surface water right for power generation on the Fryingpan River in Eagle County. Applicant is proposing to construct a small hydro-electric system which will divert 25 cfs from the Fryingpan River. Water diverted for power generation under this application will be fully consumptive to approximately 110 feet of the river.

Potential for Injury

The potential year-round diversion of 25 cfs could injure the CWCB's instream flow water right by depleting flows between the point of diversion and the point of return flow to the Fryingpan River.
