## **Summary**

This is an application for changes of water rights near Steamboat Springs in Routt County. Applicant is requesting a change in use for the Mad Ranch Pond and H.E. Turner Ditch to add stockwater, recreation, exchange, substitution and augmentation as decreed uses with priority dates relating back to the date of the original decrees. Applicant is also seeking an alternate point of diversion for the Hoelzen Pump No. 2 from the Elk River to a location on Mad Creek. Applicant claims that all uses and changes were in existence at the time of the Board's appropriations on Big Creek and the Elk River, and is requesting specific confirmation that the claimed uses are senior to the Board's decrees.

## Potential for Injury

The proposed changes in use of the subject water rights may expand diversions and may cause injury to the Board's instream flow water rights on Hot Spring Creek, Mad Creek and the Elk River, including the Board's acquired interest in the H.E. Turner Ditch. In addition, Applicant's claimed appropriation dates for the additional uses pre-date the Board's instream flow rights and could result in the claimed rights being senior to the Board's rights under Section 37-92-102(3)(b) of the statutes. Applicant needs to provide adequate documentation to CWCB of the claimed uses and appropriation dates in order to verify the applicability of Section 37-92-102(3)(b).
