Summary

Applicant seeks a plan for augmentation to augment or exchange up to 345 consumptive acre-feet of surface and ground water from the Eagle River. The replacement sources are Homestake, Eagle Park, Ruedi and Wolford Mountain Reservoirs. Use of Homestake, Ruedi or Wolford Mountain Reservoirs will require an exchange on the Eagle River at the locations where the CWCB holds instream flow water rights.
