 - Are there common areas that we can agree? Baseline Targets? (i.e. adaptive management)
 - o How is conserved water currently used and how should it be used in the future?
 - What M&I conservation goals should the West Slope M&I have?
 - Is there an empirical standard for conservation, e.g. gallons/person/day (gpd) that should be applied universally? On the Front Range only?
