
### Yampa & White River Basins Reservoir Storage Map






### Upper Colorado River Basin High/Low Monthly Precipitation Summary Based on Provisional SNOTEL data as of Jul 19, 2012






COLORADO RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average






#### SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average















### San Miguel, Dolores, Animas and San Juan River Basins Reservoir Storage Map






#### SAN MIGUEL, DOLORES, ANIMAS AND SAN JUAN RIVER BASINS Reservoir Storage Departure from Average








#### Arkansas River Basin High/Low Year-to-Date Precipitation Summary




### Arkansas River Basin Reservoir Storage Map








### Colorado SNOTEL Water Year-to-Date Precipitation Update Map




### Colorado SNOTEL Month-to-Date Precipitation







