Finance – Construction Fund Referred Non-Reimbursable Investments

**SWSI 2016** 

#### **Staff Recommendation**

Staff recommends that the Board request the General Assembly to authorize \$225,000 from the Construction Fund to be appropriated to the Department of Natural Resources for allocation to the CWCB to begin implementation of the Statewide Water Supply 2016 update.

#### **Background**

The CWCB's Water Supply Planning Section is responsible for the long-range statewide water planning activities and helps ensure the support of two critical efforts: (1) the Interbasin Compact Process (IBCC and the nine Basin Roundtables) and (2) updates to the Statewide Water Supply Initiative. The IBCC is currently engaged in a scenario planning and adaptive management planning effort for which the Water Supply Planning Section is supporting through staff and consulting assistance. Staff is also in the beginning phases of the SWSI 2016 update. In SWSI 2010, the CWCB recommended the establishment of a 6-year planning cycle for assessing Colorado's long-term consumptive and non-consumptive water needs. Since SWSI 2010, staff has received requests to re-examine the methodologies used to analyze the M&I, agricultural and non-consumptive water demands as well as consideration of varying hydrologic analyses (i.e. wet, average and dry years), climate change and drought planning. As indicated in the schedule presented below, staff is just beginning the process of evaluating the SWSI methodologies.

#### Water Project Construction Program – Project Data Non-Reimbursable Investment

**CWCB Investment:** The CWCB is just beginning to undertake the SWSI 2016 efforts and at this time, no investments have been made.

**Past use of the Funds:** The CWCB has undertaken three major efforts related to SWSI. In 2004, the CWCB adopted the SWSI Phase 1 with an approximate cost of \$2,700,000. SWSI Phase 2 was adopted by the CWCB in 2007 and costs approximately \$1,000,000. SWSI 2010 was adopted in January 2011 by the CWCB and costs approximately \$2,000,000. These projects were funded through the CWCB's Projects Bills (HB03-110 and HB05-084) and agency funds.

Current Request: This request is for funding to begin the analysis associated with the SWSI 2016 update. This includes an examination of the methodologies utilized in past versions of SWSI (2004 & 2010), consideration of additional analyses (e.g. climate change, drought planning) and recalculation of the water supply gap. For FY 2013/2014, an appropriation of \$225,000 is being sought from the Construction Fund to begin implementation SWSI 2016.
