

**Colorado Water for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century  
Metro Roundtable – Meeting Minutes**

**September 12, 2012     3:00 – 6:00 PM  
At the Denver Water – Denver Water Board Room**

Mark Koleber chaired the meeting.

Jeffrey Nathanson, chief executive officer of Recharge Colorado gave a presentation, related to proposed water and energy workshops on December 10-12 that may be held in the Denver Metro, South Platte, and Colorado River basins. These workshops will include discussions of the relationships between water and energy efficiencies and reductions in overall usage, based on a grant from the CWCB.

There was discussion of the proposed Identified Projects and Processes (IP&P) workshop for October to be coordinated by Becky Mitchell, the CWCB liaison. It was reported that the IBCC will likely assign analysis tasks to various roundtables related to the proposed IP&Ps.

Gary Thompson will seek to get updated project data from South Metro Water Supply Authority and the Town of Castle Rock. Others will also attempt to gather information for other water users.

There was discussion of Metro Roundtable participation in the Arkansas agricultural fallowing committee.

There is a potential meeting that will be set with members of the South Platte Basin Roundtable to discuss the “Water Supply Paper for the Metro Basin Roundtable”.

An update on the September IBCC meeting was provided by Joe Stibrich, Mark Wagge, and Mark Pifher.

Janet Bell gave an update on a South Platte Roundtable committee meeting concerning groundwater use.

Mark Pifher gave an update on the recent Arkansas Roundtable meeting.

Janet Bell gave an update on the recent activities and discussions of the Flaming Gorge Task Force.

The Metro Roundtable’s Education and Outreach committee met on August 30, as reported by Tom Acre.
