Introduction and Staff Recommendation

At its January 29, 2013 meeting, the Board declared its intent to appropriate two instream flow ("ISF") water rights. The purpose of this agenda item is to provide notice to the public of the two proposed ISF appropriations and to provide an opportunity for public comment pursuant to Rule 5e. of the Rules Concerning the Colorado Instream Flow and Natural Lake Level Program ("ISF Rules"). No Board action is required.

Background

Public comment will be taken on the following ISF water right appropriations being considered by the Board. The Board noticed these proposed appropriations in March and November 2012, and declared its intent to appropriate at its January 29, 2013 meeting.
