Stream and Lake Protection Section – Instream Flow Appropriation
Recommendations for January 2014

Introduction and Staff Recommendation

Pursuant to Rule 5c. of the Rules Concerning the Colorado Instream Flow and Natural Lake Level Program ("ISF Rules"), the Staff is providing notice that the following 28 stream segments have been recommended for instream flow ("ISF") appropriations in 2014. At the January 2014 CWCB meeting, Staff may request that the Board form its intent to appropriate ISF water rights on these streams.

Please note that the list below includes 9 new recommendations and 29 recommendations that were received in previous years. The older recommendations did not move forward in previous years due to the need for additional scientific data and/or ongoing attempts to address stakeholder issues. In addition, the Stream and Lake Protection Section was only able to process two recommendations in 2012 due to staff retirements at both CWCB and CPW. In 2014, staff will recommend that the Board move forward on the recommendations for which staff is able to reasonably address all outstanding issues. Staff is currently working with the recommending entities to prioritize this list of recommendations.
