

Summary

This is an application for a plan for augmentation and appropriative rights of exchange. Applicant proposes to augment depletions from new junior diversions also sought in this application with water downstream of its diversions by means of appropriative rights of exchange.

The CWCB holds the following instream flow water rights that could be injured by this application:

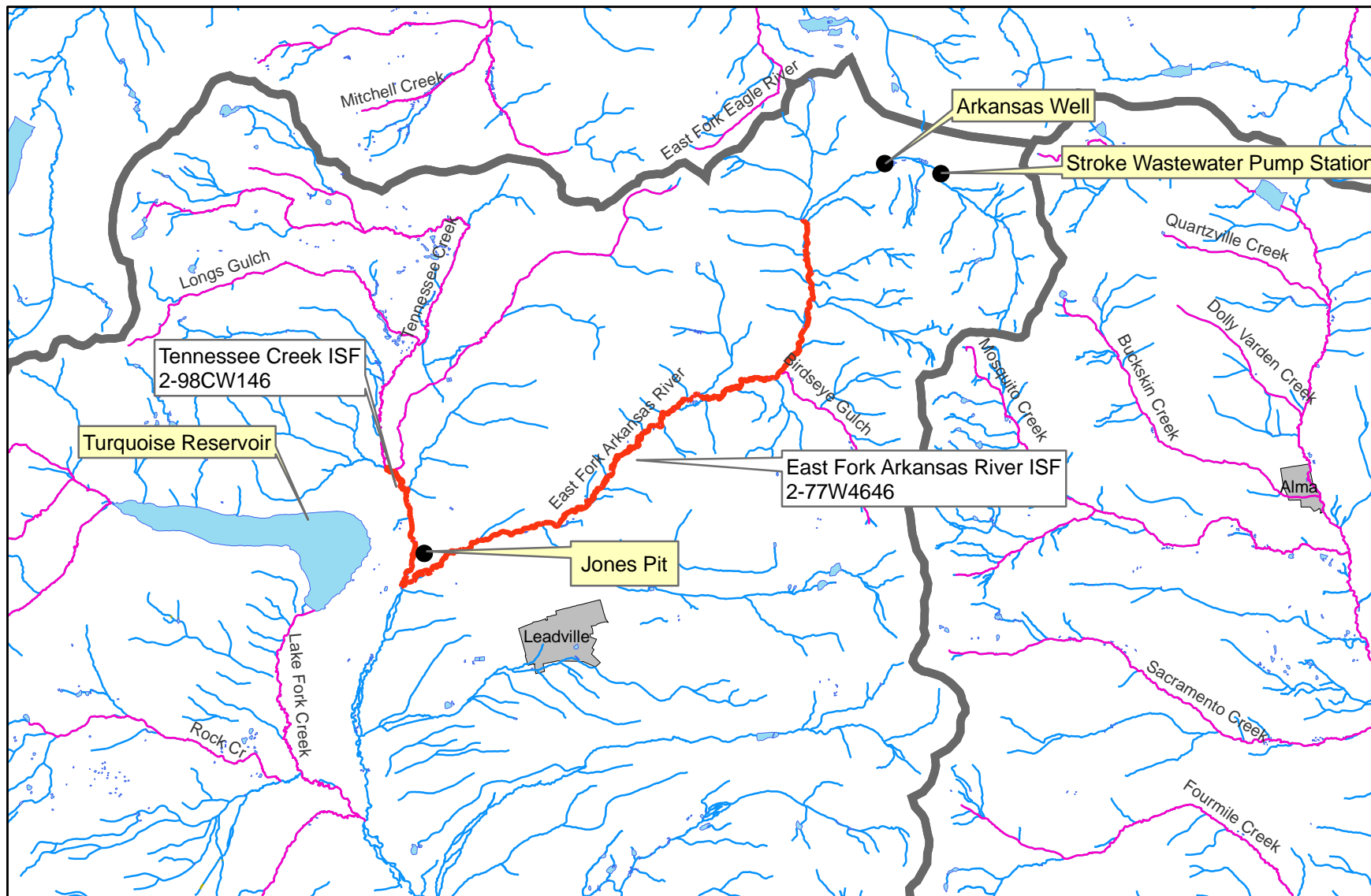
