The final of four Northwest Colorado Water Forums was held on Friday, November 5, 2010 in Hayden, Colorado. We hosted 45 registered participants and nine speakers during the four hour "Why I Need the Water!" forum. Participants came from Moffat, Rio Blanco, Routt and Larimer Counties, representing individual interests, organizational and governmental agencies. Demographics of ages, education and vocations were varied.

Nineteen evaluations were returned to us and we were encouraged by the high level of positive response.

We requested and were approved for continuing education credits for realtors and educators. Two realtors were in attendance for the fourth forum.

During the course of the four forums we hosted 270 participants and 27 speakers. Nineteen different realtors attended and earned 123 continuing education credit hours.
