

**Colorado Water for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century  
Metro Roundtable – Meeting Minutes**

Mark Koleber chaired the meeting.

Robert Sakata gave an update on recent CWCB actions and discussions.

Jacob Bornstein gave an update on the “Scenario Summaries” (draft dated October 8, 2012) by the IBCC. John Stulp assisted in the discussion. Comments on this draft are due by November 9.

John Stulp reported that the IBCC will meet on November 15 with the CWCB to discuss progress in water supply planning matters.

Julio Iturreria gave an update on the recent South Platte Roundtable meeting.

Jacob Bornstein reported that there will be a meeting of the various Roundtable chairmen to discuss education and outreach, scheduled for October 29.

Janet Bell gave an update on the activities and discussions of the Flaming Gorge Task Force. The Flaming Gorge matter will likely be one of the topics discussed at the upcoming joint IBCC and CWCB meeting.

Mark Koleber reported that Larry Cerrillo has resigned from the Metro Roundtable. He was a nonvoting representative.

Shane Michael of Leonard Rice Engineers gave a presentation on a list and map of Colorado entities that provide municipal water service to at service areas of at least 500 people. Although this is a work in progress, it is currently fairly complete.

Britta Strother is seeking to get updated Identified Project and Process (IPP) information from South Metro entities. Others are working to obtain updated information from various water users in the metro area.
