Overview and Status of Emergency Loan Requests

## Introduction (This is an Informational Item Only – No Board Action will be necessary)

In September 2013, Boulder and Larimer County experienced severe flooding which damaged or destroyed a significant number of river diversion structures and ditches along the Big Thompson River, Left Hand Creek, and St. Vrain Creek. In late September, the CWCB mobilized staff and resources to offer three-year zero-percent financing in bridge loan and long term financing. The offer was well received and resulted in over \$20 million in applications to date (See Table 1). The application deadline for emergency financing was October 1, November 1, and December 1, 2013. Processing and approval by the staff and Board occurred within one month, which allowed the applicants to move quickly into contracting, design and construction of the repairs. As of the date of this memo, approximately 2/3 of the approved applicants have entered into a CWCB loan contract and are authorized to receive loan funds.

Mike Serlet, P.E. is CWCB's Project Manager overseeing the Design and Construction phase of the Emergency Loans. Several of the projects are underway. Staff will provide an update on the status of the Emergency Loans to the Board in the Director's report. Many of the approved borrowers are also receiving WSRA grant funds via Northern Colorado WCD and funds from FEMA. Mike is working with the Northern staff to track common expenses and disbursements.

The Emergency Loan offer will remain available for those impacted by the September floods for a few more months; however, the application deadline will coincide with the application date for normal loan requests and subsequent Board approval at the regularly scheduled meeting. Staff anticipates ending the Emergency Loan offer in the spring/summer of 2014 after the irrigation season begins.
