

### **Summary**

Applicant seeks to amend plan for augmentation decreed in Case No. 5-04CW151, to which the CWCB was a party. The proposed amendment is to remove Clinton Gulch Reservoir water stored in West Lake by exchange as an augmentation source, replacing it with direct delivery of Clinton Gulch Reservoir water to West Tenmile Creek via the Tenmile Creek Pipeline and the Copper Mountain West Lake Well.

The CWCB holds the following instream flow water rights that could be injured by this application:

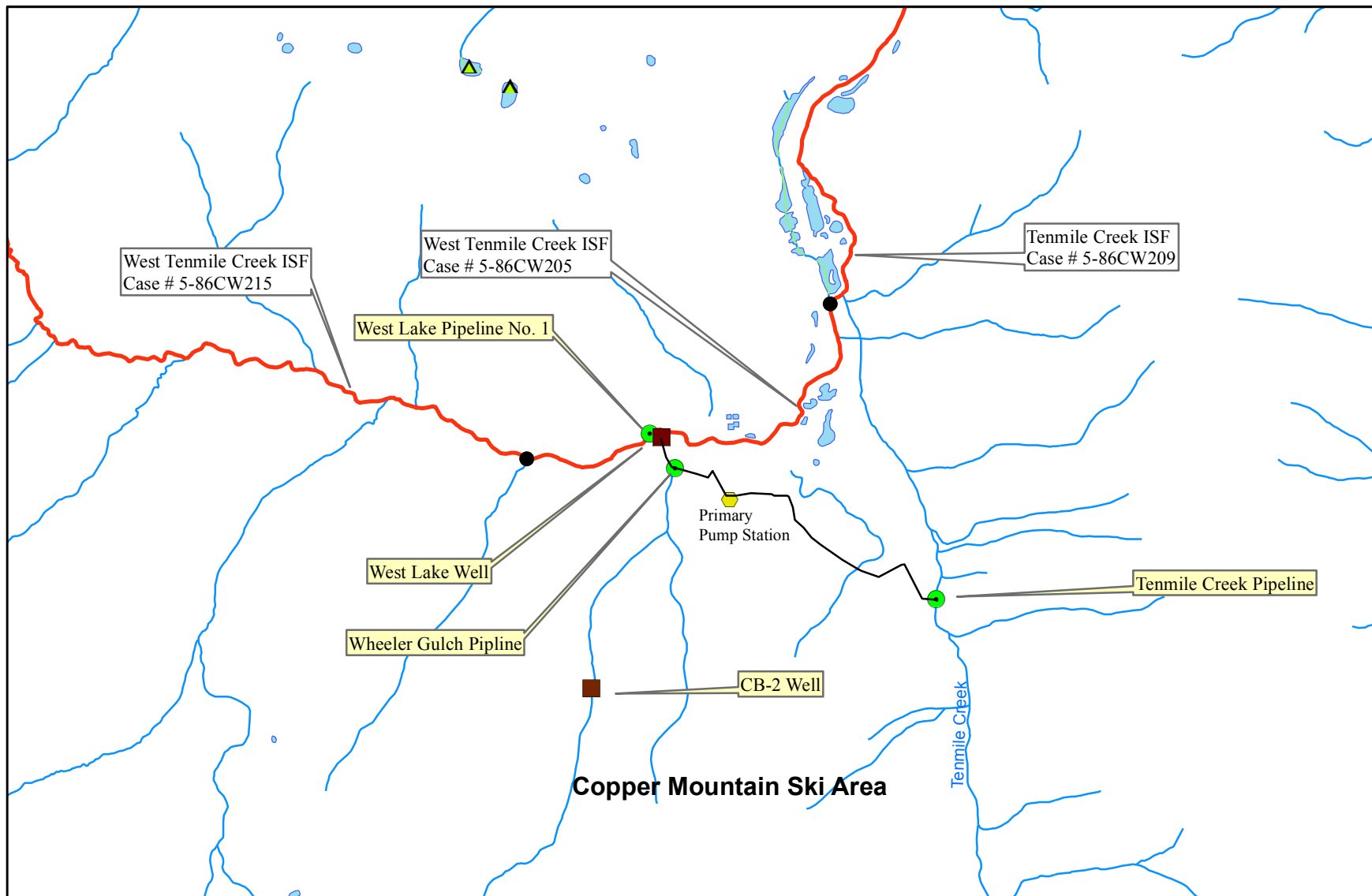
