## **Summary**

The Applicant seeks to obtain 3 new surface rights, 2 storage rights, several alternate points of diversion, a change of water right from irrigation to a new use of filling ponds and freshening flows with temporary dry-up, and a plan for augmentation and exchange using Colorado River Water Conservancy District augmentation water.

## Potential for Injury

The proposed change of water rights could cause an expansion of use and a change in the amount, location, and timing of historical return flows, which could injure CWCB's instream flow water rights.

The proposed plan for augmentation may not replace depletions in the amount, timing or location at which they occur, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
