Staff will then prepare a recommendation to the Board for approval at a future CWCB meeting. Projects will remain on this list for one year from the date of the application or until Board approval of a loan.



The Lower Arkansas Valley Water Conservancy District's mission is to acquire, retain and conserve water resources within the Lower Arkansas River; to encourage the use of such water for the socio-econonic benefit of the District citizens; and, to participate in water-related projects that will embody thoughtful conservation, responsible growth, and beneficial water usage within the Lower

Arkansas Valley. In keeping with its mission, the District plans on purchasing water to be used for augmentation purposes. The purchases will be made in two phases. Phase I will be 282 paired shares of the Colorado Canal and Lake Meredith and 126.6 paired shares of the Colorado Canal and Lake Henry. Phase II will be the purchase of 149.4 paired shares of the Colorado Canal and Lake Henry. The District has purchased Phase I using a temporary bridge loan from a local bank. An initial CWCB loan will be used to pay off the bridge loan. The District hopes to fund Phase II through WSRA grants (\$75,000 statewide funds and \$15,000 Arkansas basin funds) and another CWCB loan. The District expects to apply for the Phase I loan in early 2015.
