Dear Craig,

On December 10th, the Metro Roundtable considered the application from the Colorado Division of Water Resources to continue the installation and/or replacement of data-loggers and telemetry on major diversions within the South Platte River basin. Upon review and consideration of this application, the Metro Roundtable voted to allocate \$50,000 from its WSRA Basin Account to support this application. The Division of Water Resources had requested \$103,216 from the Metro WSRA Basin Account, therefore the Metro Roundtable further voted to support and increase in allocation in funding from the WSRA Statewide Account for \$156,432 for this project. A quorum was present at this meeting, and the votes, as described above, were unanimous.

The Roundtable recommends that the Division of Water Resources seek a permanent source of funding for the equipment needed for the data-logger/telemetry program. The Roundtable believes this program is vital to water administration, and shouldn't be subject to fluctuations in WSRA funding availability.
