# **Summary of Water Court Application**

The Applicant seeks a change in type, place and manner of use for senior water rights in Canon Heights Irrigation and Reservoir Company and Mount Pisgah Reservoir Company to add many types of uses the decreed irrigation use. Applicant also claims the right to use, reuse and successively use to extinction, and for lease, trade, exchange, sale or other arrangement outside of the service area to unidentified places of use.

Staff requests ratification of the Statement of Opposition filed to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.

## Potential for Injury

- The proposed change of water rights could cause an expansion of use and could alter the time, place and amount of historical return flows, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
