#### SECOND PREHEARING ORDER

The hearing on the Dolores River instream flow appropriation will be held in conjunction with the CWCB's meeting on September 16-18, 2015 in Montrose, Colorado, at the Holiday Inn Express & Suites Montrose, 1391 South Townsend Avenue, Montrose, CO 81401.

This hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, September 15th starting at 9:00 a.m.

#### **Issues for Hearing**

- 1) Whether there is a natural environment that can be preserved to a reasonable degree if the CWCB's water right is granted;
- 2) Whether the natural environment will be preserved to a reasonable degree by the water available for the appropriation; and,
- 3) Whether such environment can exist without material injury to water rights.

#### **Conduct of Hearing**

The Hearing will be governed by the Rules Concerning the Colorado Instream Flow and Natural Lake Level Program, including Rule 5p, which address the conduct of the hearing.

Any stipulations reached by the Parties will be presented during the hearing.

The Coordinator recommends there be no cross-examination of witnesses except by members of the Board.

Upon the close of presentations, testimony and public comment, the CWCB will deliberate. During deliberations Board members may ask clarifying questions without the necessity of reopening the record.
