**REQUESTED GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE ACTION**

The Land Advisory Committee (LAC) requests that the Governance Committee (GC) cease pursuit of tract 1014.

On October 8, 2010 the LAC voted unanimously to forward Tract 1014 to the Governance Committee with a recommendation to cease pursuit of tract 1014.

**TRACT DESCRIPTION**










Tract 1014 is approximately 157 acres in size and is located in Sections 14, T-9N, R-20W (Figure A-1). The tract is located in the Lexington to Overton bridge segment (Figure A-2).

**HABITAT CONSIDERATIONS**


Tract 1014 was considered by the LAC as non-complex wetland habitat. This parcel may lie slightly outside the Program's approved acquisition area, but more importantly there are concerns with local disturbance to target species if habitat were created here.

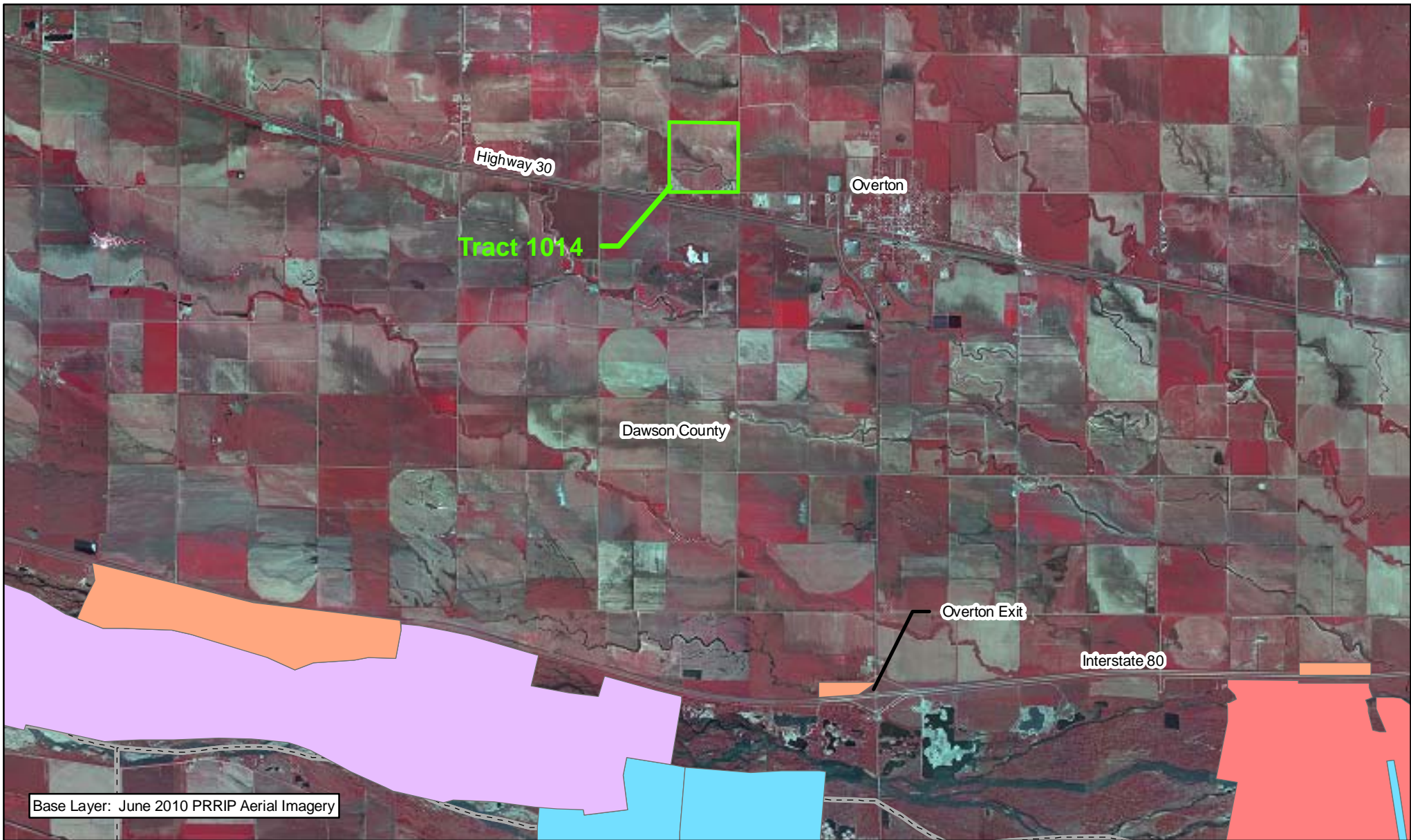

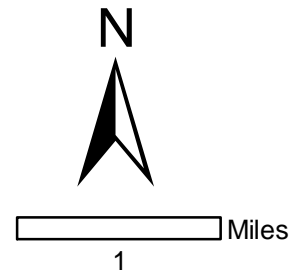
