Summary of Water Court Application

A *pro se* applicant requests simple changes in points of diversion, under § 37-92-305(3.5), C.R.S., for each of 12 points of diversion decreed in 12 separate cases. The application is unclear as to whether the irrigated area will change from the original decreed locations. Some changes may be upstream moves along instream flow water right reaches. Some of the uses may qualify as uses existing at the time of the instream flow appropriations under § 37-92-102(3)(b), C.R.S.

Staff Recommendation

Staff requests ratification of the Statement of Opposition filed to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.

Potential for Injury

- The proposed change of water rights could cause an expansion of use and could alter the time, place and amount of historical return flows, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
- Any upstream move of a point of diversion for Applicant's senior water rights could injure an intervening instream flow water right.
- Some of the water rights are claimed with senior appropriation dates. The instream flow water rights might be subject to these water rights under § 37-92-102(3)(b), C.R.S., if historical use(s) of the water rights are sufficiently documented.
