Summary of Water Court Application

Applicants seek two storage rights, a change of water rights, and an augmentation plan, including exchange. A total of four water rights are sought for the two ponds, some of which may qualify as uses existing at the time of potentially affected instream flow appropriations under § 37-92-102(3)(b), C.R.S.

Staff Recommendation

Staff requests ratification of the Statement of Opposition filed to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.

Potential for Injury

- The proposed change of water rights could cause an expansion of use and could alter the time, place and amount of historical return flows, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
- The proposed plan for augmentation and exchange may not replace depletions in the proper time, place and amount, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
- Any intended flow-through use should be identified with protective terms and conditions so that CWCB's instream flow water rights are not injured.
- Some of the water rights are claimed with senior appropriation dates. The instream flow water rights might be subject to these water rights under § 37-92-102(3)(b), C.R.S., if historical use(s) of the the water rights are sufficiently documented.

Statements of Opposition were also filed by City of Aspen, the Duroux Ditch Company and Zuma LLC.
