# Summary of Water Court Application

Applicant claims two new absolute surface water rights for the Home Supply Ditch. One is claimed with an appropriation date of April 15, 1985, several months prior to the CWCB's appropriation of certain instream flow water rights on the Roaring Fork River. The second claim includes three alternate points of diversion on Sopris Creek. Both claims are for irrigation and to "supplement irrigation by the water rights previously decreed to the Home Supply Ditch."

## Staff Recommendation

Staff requests ratification of the Statement of Opposition filed to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.
