In 2016, our conference will focus on "A River Runs Out of It: Building Strong Upstream Communities". The following sub-themes will be featured this year:

- Community conversations across agencies and interest groups
- Empowering change through social intelligence and leadership skills
- Lessons from flood recovery planning and project implementation
- Advancing technical tools and innovations for restoration
- Nexus of water storage with water quality and watershed health
- Linking river use with land use planning

Please indicate which of the bulleted points above would be covered in your talk. Submittal of your proposal does not necessarily mean it will be a part of the conference. The agenda committee will meet to discuss which submissions work best with this year's theme and will inform you by July 1 if your presentation has been accepted. At that point we'll ask you for a more detailed abstract and biography. Your submittal should include:

- Presentation title (min 15 characters, max 150 characters)
- Short overview of your presentation (min 200 characters, max 500 characters)
- Indicate if you prefer a 30 minute oral presentation, 30-90 minute panel discussion or a poster presentation
