The Colorado River at Hot Sulphur Springs, CO and Colorado River at Windy Gap near Granby, CO gages are in the reach and has been used to determine flow conditions are below the minimum for the decreed water right. The Board is hereby placing a written call for said instream flow water right to ensure that the full decreed amount of this water right is made available for the decreed beneficial use of preserving the natural environment to a reasonable degree. The effective date of this call is October 3, 2016 and the call is to be in effect until further notification from the CWCB.
