## **Legal Tweaks**

 Extend protection against loss of historical consumptive use statewide

Colo. Rev. Stat. § 37-92-305

(c) In determining the amount of historical consumptive use for a water right in division 4, 5, or 6, the water judge shall not consider any decrease in use resulting from the following:

[land conservation program, water bank, water conservation program, land fallowing program]

## **Legal Tweaks**

 Water Bank Statute – eliminate limitation to stored water

### Colo. Rev. Stat. § 37-80.5-102

The water bank program created by this article is intended to simplify and improve the approval of water leases, loans, forbearance agreements, and exchanges, including interruptible supply agreements, of stored water within each river basin, . .

.

## **Legal Tweaks**

 Water Bank Statute – allow use for Compact compliance and shortage response

Colo. Rev. Stat. § 37-80.5-102

It is also the purpose of the water banks to . . . assist the State of Colorado and water rights holders in meeting interstate compact obligations and to manage the risks associated with water shortages.

# Other Legal Tweaks

 Include interstate Compact compliance as a beneficial use

 Provide for shepherding of water to facilitate Compact compliance
