Case No. 16CW3086 (Water Division 4): Town of Crested Butte

Summary of Water Court Application

Applicant requests changes of 0.64 cfs of its contractual interest in water and an appropriative right of exchange. Changes requested include changes to points of diversion, additional places of use, and types of use for use within the Town of Crested Butte's current service area and as it is extended in the future.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board ratify the filing of a Statement of Opposition in this case to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights. A Statement of Opposition was filed on behalf of the Board in February 2017.

The CWCB holds the following instream flow water rights in Water Division 4 in the East-Taylor Watershed that could be injured by this application as follows:

Potential for Injury

- The requested upstream move of a point of diversion for Applicant's senior water rights could injure the intervening instream flow water right.
- The proposed appropriative right of exchange should be defined clearly with a reference to intervening instream flow water rights that are senior to the proposed exchange, so that the CWCB's instream flow water rights are not injured.
- The proposed change of water rights could cause an expansion of use and could alter the time, place and amount of historical return flows, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.

Statements of Opposition were also filed by the Colorado Division of Parks and Wildlife and the Parks and Wildlife Commission, Sheep Mountain Partners LLC, Skyland Metropolitan District, and Wayne Meredith.
