Case No. 16CW3181 (Water Division 5): Juniper Family Investments, LLC

Summary of Water Court Application

Applicant seeks approval of a plan for augmentation, including appropriative right of exchange to augment a claimed storage right on Snowmass Creek.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board ratify the filing of a Statement of Opposition in this case to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights. A Statement of Opposition was filed on behalf of the Board in February 2017.

The CWCB holds the following instream flow water rights in Water Division 5 in the Roaring Fork Watershed that could be injured by this application as follows:

Potential for Injury

- The proposed plan for augmentation and exchange may not replace depletions in the proper time, place and amount, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
- The proposed storage right might include a flow through diversion, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights because it is fully depletive to a segment of the intervening instream flow water rights.
