#### Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund (WPCRF)

There are currently five (5) loans in process for approximately \$9.2 million. The loan capacity for the program in 2017 is approximately \$80 million. Our annual Joint Resolution that contains the 2017 Project Eligibility List has been signed by the Governor. Currently, there are 20 projects that are intending to apply for a loan in the near future. We anticipate receiving a federal capitalization grant for FFY 2017 of approximately \$10.7 million.

# **Drinking Water Revolving Fund (DWRF)**

The loan capacity for the program in 2017 is approximately \$100 million. Our annual Joint Resolution that contains the 2017 Project Eligibility List has been signed by the Governor. Currently, there are 24 projects that are intending to apply for a loan in the near future. We anticipate receiving a federal capitalization grant for FFY 2017 of approximately \$14.5 million.

#### Water Revenue Bonds

We continue our meetings with participants in the Windy Gap Firming Project and the Northern Integrated Supply Project regarding financing options.

## Animas – La Plata Project

The Authority still holds 355 ac/ft of depletion that is under contract with the Animas La Plata Water Conservancy District for purchase in installments. The District has purchased 345 ac/ft. to date. The District has executed an installment purchase agreement with Lake Durango Water Authority that will most likely mean an accelerated purchase schedule from the Authority.

## **CWCB – Authority Joint Funding Opportunities**

We continue the efforts of the Statewide Funding Committee and work with CWCB staff to investigate viable funding mechanisms for future water projects.
