ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME UNDER ARTICLES 417 AND 418

(Issued July 23, 2001)

The licensee for the Kingsley Dam Project has requested an extension of time to comply with the filing requirements of articles 417 and 418 of the license, 1/ as amended. 2/ Amended articles 417 and 418 require the filing of a final wildlife management plan for Jeffery Island. The project is located on the North Platte and Platte Rivers, in Garden, Keith, Lincoln, Dawson, and Gosper Counties, Nebraska.

The licensee requests the additional time to continue ongoing consultations with and receive comments from the resource agencies prior to finalizing and filing the plan. The licensee states that the resource agencies support the extension request. The reasons advanced by the licensee in support of the requested extension of time are reasonable and justify the extension.

The Director orders:

(A) The deadline for submitting the final management plan required under license articles 417 and 418 is extended to July 27, 2001.
