Re: Colorado Water Collaboratory Progress Report – 75% Completion

The Colorado Water Collaboratory Project is nearing completion, and we are now compiling student/faculty/staff surveys at the University of Colorado – Boulder, Colorado Mesa University, and Metropolitan State University of Denver (MSU Denver). Dr. Chad Mortensen of MSU Denver's Psychology Department is leading this effort.

Representatives from each of the three universities have acquired campus water use data for 2015-2016 academic periods. Each data set is different, and that is part of the analysis in terms of how best to present this data for easy interpretation.

We are looking at water metering needs and new technologies to improve the utilization of water use data on the three campuses. This is an interesting aspect of this work, and will help us assess best practices and best technologies for future work.

We plan to have the final report completed by June 10, 2017.
