21	Finance Committee Chair Purcell called the meeting to order at 10:45 a.m. Central time. No agenda
22	modifications were offered. Lawson moved to approve August 2010 FC minutes; Kraus seconded.
23	August 2010 minutes approved.
24	August 2010 minutes approved.
25	Program Bid Packages
26	Kenny provided an update on the Cottonwood Ranch and Elm Creek Complex habitat enhancement bid
27	packages. Both packages included conditions related to Corps permit approval. The Corps stated these
28	permits are forthcoming. For the Elm Creek Complex work, a second condition related to the
29	management and monitoring agreement with NPPD which the GC approved yesterday. Both bid
30	packages are now open for bidding and will be awarded once complete.
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32	Purcell asked about the new bid package cost for the OCSW work at Cottonwood Ranch. Farnsworth
33	said the bid package is for construction of tern and plover habitat at Cottonwood Ranch. He said the
34	contractor used a new cost-estimating technique that resulted in a cost estimate that exceeds the budget
35	amount but that also reflects much larger estimates for actual work than we have seen before. If bids
36	come in comparable to past work, we should be able to stay within the remaining budget for the LP-2 line
37	item. If bids come in higher, we will have to come back to the FC to discuss moving funds from another
38	budget line item unless the bid packages open for other work in that line item provide cost savings.
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40	Harmon moved to approve the Cottonwood Ranch OCSW bid package with the condition that there will
41	be Finance Committee approval if budget adjustments are required; George seconded. <b>Bid package</b>
42	approved.

44	Farnsworth said the culvert bid package is ready to go and is for construction of a crossing over Spring
45	Creek to improve access to Cottonwood Ranch for Program activities. Kenny said this project does
46	require a 404 permit. We have not received the permit and there is a lead federal agency question related
47	to this permit that is unresolved. Kenny said there is a conference call with the Corps set for next week to

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discuss this issue. Barels said he knows the Program needs to get over the hurdle, but if it would help to get this project completed this year NPPD would be happy to take the lead on this permit. Kenny said he appreciates this option and will consider it. Kraus said it seems like this is a project that is on a small enough scale to work this issue out without stalling other important work. Kenny said it seems like that may be the reason the Corps chose this project to push on the lead federal agency matter. Purcell said it might be a good argument to show how state contributions with cash and water are actually more than 50% of Program contributions. Lawson said it seems to be more than that and it seems the Corps does not want to accept the Program as an entity like NPPD in acquisition of permits.

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Kraus moved to approve the Cottonwood Ranch culvert bid package subject to the resolution of the 404 permitting issues; Schneider seconded. **Bid package approved.**
