Shoemaker Island FSM Proof of Concept Experiment

Farnsworth discussed the FSM Proof of Concept contract amendment for continued work at the Shoemaker Island Complex.

Schneider moved to approve the contract amendment; Urie seconded. Contract amendment approved.

Elm Creek Island Rebuild

Farnsworth discussed the bid package to rebuild tern/plover nesting islands at the Elm Creek Complex. Campbell asked if this is the expected outcome of a short-duration high flow. Farnsworth said yes, lower level sandbars are expected to be overtopped, eroded, and re-worked at flows of this magnitude. Smith said this is part of the learning happening on the river and it will generate data that will be delivered to the GC for decision-making in the near future.

LaBonde moved to approve the bid package; Urie seconded. Bid package approved.

Program Database

Farnsworth discussed the contract amendment for ongoing maintenance and administration of the Program web site and database.

Urie moved to approve the contract amendment; LaBonde seconded. Contract amendment approved.

Tern/Plover Monitoring

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Water Management Projects Modeling

Kenny discussed the contract to develop a more comprehensive modeling tool to evaluate how water projects interact and whether the project scores are realistic. Campbell asked if this is a sole source contract.

- Kenny said yes so this will be moved to the GC for final approval either by electronic vote with the ISR RFP or at the March GC meeting. Urie asked if there were economies of scale that are important to consider

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North Platte Chokepoint

Kenny discussed the contract amendment for permitting related to flood proofing activities at the State Channel at the North Platte Choke Point. Urie asked if we will be successful in getting a permit for this work. Kenny said he believes a permit can be secured.

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Urie moved to approve the contract amendment; Schneider seconded. Contract amendment approved.

Campbell said he invited Kenny to discuss sediment augmentation last week in Omaha with several federal officials working on the Missouri River and he represented the Program very well. Kenny said it was a good opportunity to get in front of an important audience.
