Directions from Silverthorne (Or the Trough Road from

Wolcott, which is what I take to and from Glenwood Springs. Just turn left on Highway 9 at the end and directions are the same):

On Highway 9 traveling north toward Kremmling, when the town becomes visible, before you cross the Colorado River, take a right on County Road 33. County Road 33 (River Road) parallels the Colorado

River on the **South Side.** Travel 5 miles until County Road 33 intersects County Road 39. At the intersection, you will see two large red buildings, they are the only red buildings in the valley. Turn into either driveway and the meeting will take place in the red building to the north.
